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ORDINANCE #4-2020 - FY 2020-2021 Budget

(Updates to Section 5)

WHEREAS, due to the current state-wide economic conditions and receiving the latest appraised property values, from Berkeley County, the City must make the final calculation of the Hanahan Local Option Sales Tax credit for tax year 2021; and

WHEREAS, a result of these circumstances, it is necessary to amend the fiscal year 2020-2021 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has analyzed these figures to assure that budget adjustments are required and has made recommendations that maintain the overall balance of revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Hanahan City Council to amend the budget in conformance with these recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HANAHAN, SOUTH CAROLINA:

Section 1. The following budget adjustments are hereby adopted and approved:

General Fund: Original Language Budget Ordinance 4-2020 adopted 6/9/2020

SECTION 5: As required by law, 71% of the Local Option Sales Tax Fund will be distributed as tax relief to taxpayers; this amount is one million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$1,800,000). The City will retain 29% of total LOST funds, seven hundred thirty-five thousand and two-hundred and eleven dollars (\$735,211). The retained funds will be used for general operating in the following ways: 17% Fleet purchases (\$430,985), 7% Facility Maintenance (\$177,465), and 5% Capital Projects (\$126,761). Tax credits are based upon a LOST credit factor of .00120442. Section 5 of this Ordinance is made pursuant to Sections 4-10-10 through 4-10-100 of the Code of Law of South Carolina.

General Fund: Updated Language Budget Amendment

SECTION 5: As required by law, the Property Tax Credit Fund revenue will be distributed as tax relief to taxpayers. The Property Tax Credit Fund revenue is forecasted to be one million six hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$1,650,000). Section 5 of this Ordinance is made pursuant to Sections 4-10-10 through 4-10-100 of the Code of Law of South Carolina.

Section 2. The following budget adjustments are hereby adopted and approved:

General Fund

Decrease State Revenue Property Tax Relief (10.3516.0000)	(\$150,000)
Increase Transfer from Fund Balance Revenue (10.3584.0000)	\$150,000

Section 3. The within ordinance to become effective upon its second reading and approval. Enacted this the 13th day of October 2020.
